JCB LiveLink is a telematics platform for real-time monitoring of heavy machinery: 600,000+ connected assets streaming telemetry into an AWS data lake, with petabytes of data stored and around 6 billion machine alerts processed. I work across an architecture of around 30 microservices with C#, .Net, TypeScript, Angular, NgRx, and AWS, and own three of the platform's applications end-to-end, from design and delivery through to production support.

Key Achievements:

- Designed and built a multi-application consent management service, a full C# API and database where admins create and publish versioned consent content per application, user preferences such as marketing and data usage are captured, and every interaction is recorded in an audit trail with content hashes to verify exactly what was accepted.
- Led the delivery of a customisable telemetry dashboard for visualising machine time-series data: ran sprint planning and delivery coordination, and built the CRUD API for managing dashboards and the API for querying the time-series data.
- Act as the team's go-to person for onboarding new developers, mentoring new starters and getting them up to speed with the system and its architecture.
- Drove engineering standards across the platform: introduced SonarQube static analysis across multiple repositories, led the adoption of Prettier across the codebase, and identified the cookie-consent compliance gap before sourcing and implementing OneTrust to close it.
- Delivered a major frontend migration from Angular v15 to v20, ensuring compatibility and minimising disruption.
- Implemented branch deploys using AWS CloudFormation and ECS, allowing changes to be automatically deployed, tested, and demonstrated prior to merging into staging.
- Created a proxy service integrating with a third-party supplier to bring tyre pressure monitoring data into the platform.
